NEW CATEGORIES FOR 2010 (Note: one price for resident and non-resident)

Twilight – Family or individual who elect to use the pool only during the evenings and weekends. Special badges will be issued for this type membership. Eligible for day passes all season.

Lessons Only – Individuals who may have regular access to a private pool but desire improving their ability or technique. Eligible for day passes all season.

Nanny Registration - Those families who wish to register a nanny should pay a separate non-resident individual fee with their family registration. If the identity of the nanny is unknown at the time of registration,

“Nanny to be named” should be written on the registration form. If the “Nanny to be named” is a resident, the monetary difference of the membership will be refunded.

Guest Policy & Fees

A sponsoring member must register all guests and they are required to wear a guest badge at all times. A deposit of \$1.00 is required for each guest badge. The daily guest fee is \$20.00 per day for a family and \$7.00 per day for an individual. Prior arrangements must be made with the Manager for groups of 10 or more.

Refund Policy

****No Refunds will be given after May 29, 2010 (Opening Day). If you wish to receive a refund before opening day, please submit your request in writing to the pool commission. There will be a \$50.00 fee for all refunds.****

How to Join

- 1) Complete the application in full.
- 2) Make your check payable to the “**Nor-Gwyn Pool Commission**” for the appropriate amount and mail to the address at the head of this notice.
- 3) Pick up tags and have photo I.D badges validated at the attendant’s booth during pool hours at your convenience. Please do not mail in your old photo I.D. or badge with your application. Validation of photo I.D. cards from prior years will be handled the first time you attend during summer 2010.
- 4) Patrons may register at the pool during regular operating hours.

Photo I.D. and Badge Policy

The I.D. cards will be needed each time you enter the pool complex, along with your 2010 badges. Lost photo I.D. cards will be replaced at a cost of \$10.00. Photo I.D. cards for new members will be taken at the registration session at a cost of \$3.00 per badge if an appropriate picture is supplied or \$5.00 if a picture is taken by the Pool Staff. Children who have changed significantly will be re-photographed as necessary. We also ask that after you have picked up your new badges that you keep them on your suits at all times upon entering the pool area.

Important Information -

During 2009 we opened certain areas for food and snacks and will continue that offering for this summer. We also ask that floatation devices not be used in the pool except during Flick N Float events. We thank you for your compliance with these rules to help us keep Nor-Gwyn Pool safe and clean.
